NORTH-EAST COAST OF ENGLAND RIVER TEES AND HARTLEPOOL

MOORING/UNMOORING OF VESSELS IN THE PORTS OF TEES AND HARTLEPOOL

Mariners are reminded of the following:

The practice of using ships' crews to moor/unmoor vessels has been deemed unsafe and the use of Foyboatmen is mandatory.

For the purpose of this Notice, the term "vessels" excludes pleasure craft (<20m), fishing vessels (operating from the Fish Quay and North Basin only), PD Teesport operated craft, licensed harbour tugs and compliant work boats.

A vessel shifting within the Ports may use ship's crew to move mooring lines provided that they remain on the quay until the vessel has safely moored in the new position, the gangway has been rigged and there are sufficient crew remaining on board to carry out the operation safely.

Any vessel manoeuvring using engines and/or thrusters shall be deemed to be navigating whether or not there is a line ashore and, therefore, ship's crew cannot be used.
